Nonetheless, the research fellow may be awarded with honorarium at the successful completion of the initial period (six months) subject to the availability of sufficient funds, along with certificate(s) of completion for the initial period.
4. The research fellow may carry on his/her ongoing professional, academic, technical, or scholarly activities/engagements (if any) during the period of fellowship.
