Thematic Areas

The conference invites contributions in the following key areas:

1. **Scientific Knowledge Production, Technology, and Innovation**– Discovering how scientific advancements fuel the political economy and environmental sustainability.
2. **Artificial Intelligence (AI), Emerging Technologies, and Society**– Exploring impact of AI on governance, industry, and society.
3. **Health, STEAM (Science, Technology, Engineering, Arts, and Mathematics) Education, and the Knowledge-Based Economy**– The role of education and research in driving sustainable progress.
4. **Digital Space, E-Commerce, and Emerging Business Models**– The role of digital transformation in economic resilience and sustainable business practices.
5. **Cultural Heritage, Tourism, and Indigenous Knowledge**– Understanding how cultural heritage and indigenous knowledge contribute to sustainability and local economic development.
6. **Language, Literature & Psychology in the Age of Technology**– Examining the evolving relationship between technology and psycho-cultural expression.
7. **Climate Change, Energy, and Sustainability**– Addressing climate action, renewable energy solutions, and sustainable environmental policies.
8. **Sustainable Development**– Exploring multi-dimensional approaches to achieving the SDGs.

Deadline for all abstracts: Saturday, April 12, 2025.

Abstract Guidelines

- Abstracts for individual paper presentations: Single paragraph, double spaced, and approximately 150-250 words.
- Oral presentation must be of maximum 20 minutes, followed by 10 minutes' discussion.
- Abstract must be complete research study and original work of the authors- supplements which are cited from other research works will not be accepted.
- Title must be relevant to the content of the abstract.
- The objectives for the research must clearly outline what the research had set out to achieve.
- The methodology used in the research must be briefly outlined in the abstract, and any limitations in the methodology must be addressed.
- Key findings of the study must clearly be stated including any statistical significance or trends.
- The abstracts must be coherent and understandable.
- Abstracts must demonstrate adequate knowledge of the subject matter and produce impactful and relevant data.
- The content of the abstract must strive to be as original as possible. Abstracts which present ideas or research from an angle that has rarely/never been done before will be scored higher than abstracts which are repeating previously or extensively done published research.
